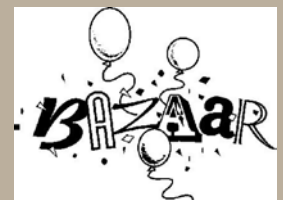

## A MESSAGE FROM OUR BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR...

Summer is that time of year when families attempt to escape from our daily work and busy schedules to spend some much needed quality time together. I have heard from so many of you talking about your vacations and your smiling faces as you reflect upon the experience. This is truly exciting to hear and see as we have had such a rough economic season over the last few years.

Our church has been very busy this summer as well. There have been international mission trips, local mission opportunities, choir tours, Bible studies, children's activities, end-of-year and back-to-school bashes, utility bills, lawn care, etc. that have been supported, hosted and paid by the church. As everyone knows, there is always a cost to an activity or function and the church is no exception to this. Most churches experience financial "belt tightening" during the summer as this is the time of the year when expenses are much higher than income. For those of you who are not business savvy, we call this "being in the red." Last month, I told you that we were in a shortfall situation. We are now even further behind as our pledged giving is approximately \$100,000 below our budgeted, or expected, income.

In early October, you will receive your third quarter contribution statement. My hope is that you will prayerfully consider where you are with your general operating fund pledge and if you are behind, work towards getting caught up as soon as you can. 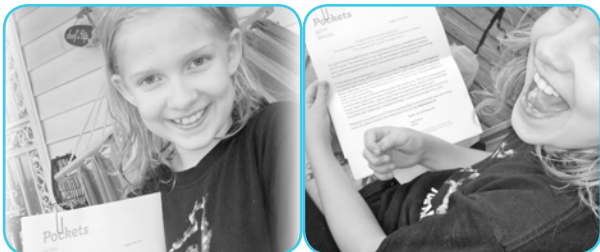
