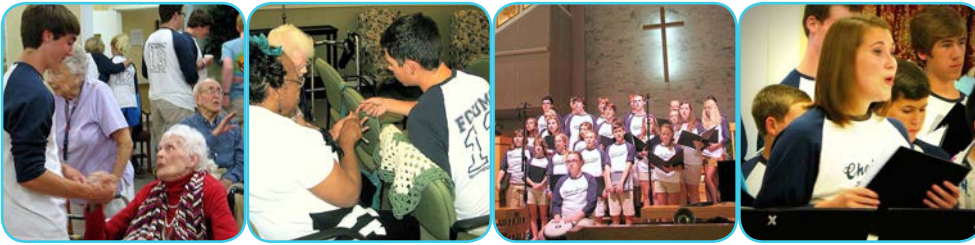

## A MESSAGE FROM OUR BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR...

I am continually amazed by the generosity of our church. We have certainly made significant impacts on the lives of our members, people in Knoxville, as well as nationally and internationally, through our ministries and programs. Although we have been able to accomplish much this year, we have started to feel the financial effects of the "summer slump" in regards to our 2013 financial budget. The "summer slump" is what I call the reduced giving during the summer months.

As our congregation enjoys their summer vacations, we see attendance, and thus giving, fall below what we require to keep the church operating. As of July 31, our general fund receipts are approximately \$78,000 behind our 2013 operating budget requirements. I am telling you this not to spread "gloom and doom," but to make you aware of our financial shortfall. The church staff continues to be good financial stewards of your generosity, but it starts impacting our ministries when they have to cut back or stop spending all together.

My prayer is that our general fund giving will increase over the next several weeks to overcome the shortfall from the "summer slump" and meet our operation and ministry financial needs through the end of this year. Thank you for your continued support and faithfulness to our church. If you have any questions concerning about how you can assist us in on-going efforts to overcome our financial challenges, please do not hesitate to contact me.
