## Classes for Adults

### Second Sunday Bible Study | Wesley Hall

Looking for an easy way to meet other people, learn about the Bible, and meet one of our pastors? On the second Sunday of every month, one of our pastors leads a stand-alone, topical Bible study you can jump into anytime. Each session is welcoming and accessible to those new to faith, while still offering practical insight for long-time followers of Jesus. Come as you are & come as you can. No preparation required.

### Christian Homebuilders | Room 137

Christian Homebuilders, a Bible study class, began over 50 years ago as a young married couples' class and has evolved into a class of over 70 members, married and single, whose are 60 and up. We pray and care for each other, and we have fun together, with four social gatherings each year. We are proud of our mission outreach, our support of foreign missionaries, and national & local families and causes. We welcome new members.

### Cornerstone | Room 205

We use a collaborative selection of studies using amplify media, Josh Scott's *Context*, and Bible stories. We're a very social, service-oriented group. Our class is relaxed and informal. Discussions on Bible studies incorporate current social issues that make the Bible relevant and engaging. We focus on making our relationship with God the Cornerstone of our lives.

### The Damascus Class | Room 104

On the road to Damascus, the apostle Paul encountered the resurrected Christ in a life and mission altering way. This young adult class is geared towards those who long for deeper connections but are always on the go. This is a place to land and connect with others seeking faith connections with zero judgment when you miss a few weeks.

### Discovery Bible | Library/ Room 112

This class is open to anyone who desires a deeper study of the Scriptures and how they apply to our lives today. Our studies not only include delving verse-by-verse into a book of the Bible, but also periodic book studies and discipleship studies. Discovery Bible Class consists of both couples and singles, and we have an active prayer ministry bringing our concerns and praises to God for our friends, families, church family, the nation and the world. We also help with outreach opportunities as the need arises.

### Discipleship | Room 136

We seek how to be effective and faithful followers of Christ in all aspects of life through the study of Jesus' words as recorded in the gospel.

### FOCUS | Room 210

FOCUS (Followers of Christ, United to Serve) is a multigenerational group of believers who study scripture primarily using the Adult Bible Studies book. We are active in many ministries of the church and participate in various outreach and mission opportunities. We share our lives with each other, laughing and crying and supporting one another with our prayers and encouragement through challenging times and good times.

### Growth and Connection | Room 138 | April 12-May 17

A six-week class examining personality, communication, and relationships. No pressure. No perfect people. Just growth. Yes—this class is designed for real life. Not a church member? You're welcome. New to Bible study? You're welcome. Don't have it all figured out? Neither do we! We will use *I Said This... You Heard That* by Kathleen Edelman to help people improve communication by understanding how their temperament (or "wiring") affects how they speak and how others hear them. It uses a color-coded system and a 40-question assessment to provide a framework for better conversations with loved ones and colleagues, focusing on how to use words more effectively and avoid misunderstandings.

### Insight | Room 107

We are a diverse collection of folks searching for insights into God's presence and guidance in our lives and in the world. Insight is a safe and caring forum to ask questions, share our burdens with each other, and to build community. Our studies are generally short-term multi-week studies that reveal the relevance of scripture to challenges we face today.

### Open Door Class | Room 111

We are a group of believers seeking to learn and understand more about our faith through Bible study, discussion, fellowship, and application in our daily lives. We strive to serve through sponsoring individuals in need, shut-in visitation and fund-raising. Our door is open to all!

### Pairs & Spares | Room 106

As its name suggests, the Pairs & Spares class is made up of married couples and singles. The class studies the Bible foundations to deal with Christian issues in everyday life. We focus on events in scripture, people in scripture, and attributes of God. The class is a warm fellowship that joins in outreach projects, support activities, and social occasions as well.

### Seekers | Room 203

We are folks from our 30's to 50+. We have members who are new to FCUMC and some who grew up here. Historically, the class picks books from the Bible for in-depth studies. Lessons are very much interactive with discussions.

### Whobodies | Room 206

We are focused on caring for each other and our community. The name comes from a children's book, *Whobody There*. Missions include a targeted outreach to single mothers, food pantry support, and work with Wesley House senior adults. We use lectionary Bible studies and other study sources.

### Women's Thrive Group | Room 102

This class is a multi-generational and diverse group of women striving to grow in our faith. We choose study materials to help us strengthen our understanding of God and His will for our lives. Through building our faith, we are growing in our walk with God—which is essential to having an abundant life.
