Infants and Toddlers

The Infants and Toddlers meet in the Early Childhood Ministry hallway on the first floor of the church.

Elementary Age Children

Youth (Grades 6 through 12)

Youth in Grades 6 through 12 initially meet downstairs in the Net Room before breaking out into smaller, age appropriate classes. The Net is located below the sanctuary.

Young Adults/ College Students

A class for high school seniors through college seniors where we focus on keeping young adults spiritually connected during their college years when so many transitions are happening in their lives. Learning to live away from home or more independently while becoming responsible for their own daily living, as well as focusing on academics can make it difficult to find time for a spiritual connection to God. We try to make current events happening around this group relevant to their spiritual connection to God through the scriptures.

Adults of All Ages

Pairs & Spares

As its name suggests, the Pairs & Spares class is made up of married couples and singles, mostly in the middle-aged range. The class studies the Bible foundations to deal with Christian issues in everyday life. The class is a warm fellowship that joins in outreach projects, support activities, and social occasions as well.

F.I.S.H.

F.I.S.H. is a community of believers, married and single, with and without children, who are in fellowship and service to Christ and to those living in our community. We participate in discussion-formatted Sunday school lessons that are inquisitive and sometimes unexpectedly probing.
